## **materials:**

- YARNS (I used Himalaya Dolphin Baby for the body, overalls, pockets and ears bows and YarnArt Jeans for the nose)
- HOOK ( I used 4 mm)
- SAFETY EYES ( I used 12 mm, you can embroider the eyes or use felc)
- DARNING NEEDLE to sew body parts
- STUFFING
- SCISSORS

## **stitch abbreviations:**

- MR = magic ring
- INC = increase
- SC = single crochet
- DEC = decrease
- FLO = front loops only
- BLO = back loops only
- CH = chain
- SL ST = slip stitch
- F.O. = fasten off



## head (with hat):

### hat color

R1. 6SC in MR (6)

R2. 6 inc (12)

R3. (1SC, inc) x 6 (18)

R4. (2SC, inc) x 6 (24)

R5. (3SC, inc) x 6 (30)

R6. (4SC, inc) x 6 (36)

R7- 8. SC in each (36)

R9. in FLO, INC in each (72)

R.10. (1SC, inc) x 36 (108)

- sl st and F.O

### head color

working in the BLO of R9,  
and SC in each (36)

R10-15. SC in each (36)

R16. (2SC, dec) x 9 (27)

- add safety eyes between  
rounds 13 and 14, 7 st apart
- stuff

R17. (7SC, dec) x 3 (24)

R18. (2SC, dec) x6 (18)

- sl st and F.O
- stuff some more
- embroider a nose

between rounds 13 and 14,  
mouth from 14 to 15



## head (without hat):

R1. 6SC in MR (6)

R2. 6 inc (12)

R3. (1SC, inc) x 6 (18)

R4. (2SC, inc) x 6 (24)

R5. (3SC, inc) x 6 (30)

R6. (4SC, inc) x 6 (36)

R7-15. SC in each (36)

R16. (2SC, dec) x 9 (27)

- add safety eyes between rounds 13 and 14, 7 st apart

- stuff

R17. (7SC, dec) x 3 (24)

R18. (2SC, dec) x 6 (18)

- sl st and F.O.

- stuff some more

- embroider a nose between rounds 13 and 14, mouth from 14 to 15

## ears (make 2):

R1. 7SC in MR (7)

R2. 7 inc (14)

R3. (1SC, inc) x 7 (21)

R4-13. SC in each (21)

R14. (2SC, dec) x 5, 1 SC (16)

R15-23. SC in each (16)

- sl st and F.O, leave long tail to sew

- don't stuff!

- sew an ear to each side of head, between rounds 4 and 5





## body:

### first leg

R1. 6SC in MR (6)

R2. 6 inc (12)

R3-6. SC in each (12)

- sl st and F.O

### second leg

R1. 6SC in MR (6)

R2. 6 inc (12)

R3-6. 12 SC. ch2 at the end of 6 round

R7. join to first leg with a sc, 11SC, 2SC in ch2, 12SC, 2SC in ch2 (28)

- stuff legs

R8. (6SC, inc) x 4 (32)

R9. (7SC, inc) x 4 (36)

R.10-13. SC in each (36)

R14. (7SC, dec) x 4 (32)

## arms (make two):

R1. 5 SC in MR (5)

R2. 5 inc (10)

R3-7. SC in each (10)

- sl st and F.O, leave long tail to sew, stuff
- sew each arm to round 17 of 19 of the body

R15. SC in each (32)

R16. (6 SC, dec) x 4 (28)

R17-18. 28SC

- stuff

R19. (5SC, dec) x 4 (24)

R20. (2SC, dec) x 6 (18)

- stuff some more

- sl st and F.O, leave long tail to sew head



## overall:

### first leg

ch17

R1. join to first ch with a SC, 15SC (16)

R2-3. SC in each (16)

• sl st and F.O

### second leg

ch17

R1. join to first ch with a SC, 15SC (16)

R2-3. SC in each (16), ch2 at the end round 3

R4. join to first leg with a SC, 15SC, 2SC in ch2, 16SC, 2SC in ch2 (36)

R5-9. SC in each (36)

R10. (10SC, dec) x3 (33)

!DO NOT CUT YARN! (make bib)

## Before starting overall:

- test the size around the legs before continuing to round 2
- If it's too tight, use a crochet hook 1-2 mm larger
- the bib should be in the middle (you can add/subtract SC)

### bib

start where you left off the row 10

- 5SC, ch1 and turn, 8SC
- (ch1 and turn, 8SC) x 2 (make x 3-4 as you prefer)
- sl st and F.O



## pockets (makes 2):

ch7

- SC in 2nd ch from hook, 5SC, (ch1 and turn, 6SC) x3
- sl st and F.O, leave tail to sew each pants leg

## bows (makes 2):

If you don't make hat, you can  
make this

ch8

- SC in 2nd ch from hook, 6SC, (ch1 and turn, 7SC) x2
- sl st and F.O <- rectangle
- with a separate piece of yarn, make a knot in the middle of the rectangle to form a bow and sew to ear or head

## pocket (on bib):

ch6

- SC in 2nd ch from hook, 4SC, (ch1 and turn, 5SC) x4
- sl st and F.O, leave tail to sew to bib

## straps (makes 2):

Ch 14 (make shorter or longer as you prefer)

- SC in 2nd ch from hook, 12SC (13)
- F.O, leave long tail
- Sew the straps to the corners of the bib and to the back of the shorts with a separate piece of yarn (with a distance of 6 SC)
