



## MATERIALS:

- ✓ Himalaya Velvet Brown 1 yarn.
- ✓ Himalaya Velvet White 1 yarn.
- ✓ 3.0 mm crochet hook.
- ✓ 12 mm safety eyes (14, 16mm.)
- ✓ Thin thread for sewing parts.
- ✓ Black and white threads for embroidering details.
- ✓ Sewing needle and scissors.
- ✓ Fiberfill.

# ABBREVIATIONS:

R - row

MR - magic ring

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

inc - 2 sc. in the next stitch

dec - single crochet 2 stitches together


BLO - back loop only

[...] - number of stitches you should have at the end of the row (...) - repeat whatever is





## ARMS: (MAKE 2)

#### Let's start with White:

R 1: 6sc in MR.

**R 2:** (inc)\*6. [12]

**R 3:** (1sc, 1inc)\*6 [18]

**R 4:** 18sc. (1 row)

### Change to Brown yarn:

**R 5:** 6sc, 3dec, 6sc. [15]

**R 6:** 5sc, 2dec, 6sc. [13]

R7 - 11: 13sc. (5 rows)

R 12: 6sc, 1dec, 5sc. [12]

R 13: 5sc, 1dec, 5sc. [11]

R 14: 4sc, 1dec, 5sc. [10]

**R 15 – 16:** 10sc. (2 rows)

R 17: 1sc, and fold the top

opening flat and 5sc, through

both sides across.

Fill with fiber.

Leaving yarn for the arm to





R 1: 8sc in MR.

**R 2:** (inc)\*8. [16]

**R 3:** (1sc, 1inc)\*8. [24]

**R 4:** (2sc, 1inc)\*8. [32]

**R 5:** 32sc. (1 row)



R6-7:32sc. (2 rows)

**R 8:** (6sc, 1dec)\*4. [28]

R 9: 28sc. (1 row)

R 10: (5sc, 1dec)\*4. [24]

**R 11:** 24sc. (1 row)

R 12: (4sc, 1dec)\*4. [20]

**R 13:** 20sc. (1 row)

**R 14:** (3sc, 1dec)\*4. [16]

**R 15:** 16sc. (1 row)

**R 16:** (2sc, 1dec)\*4. [12]

R 17: 12sc.

R 18: 3sc. and fold the top


opening flat and 6sc, through

## LEGS: (MAKE 2)

#### Let's start with White:

**R** 1: 8sc in MR.

**R 2:** (inc)\*8. [16]

**R 3:** (1sc, 1inc)\*8 [24]

**R 4:** (3sc, 1inc)\*6 [30]

**R 5:** <u>BLO</u> 30sc. [30]

**R 6:** 30sc. (1 rows)

**R** 7: 6sc, (1sc, 1dec)\*6, 6sc. [24]

R 8: 6sc, 6dec, 6sc. [18]



R9 - 11: 18sc. (3 rows)

**R 12:** (4sc, 1dec)\*3. [15]

**R 13 – 14:** 15sc. (2 rows)

**R 15:** (3sc, 1dec)\*3. [12]

**R 16 – 19:** 12sc. (4 rows)

R 20: 3sc. and fold the top opening

flat and 6sc, through both sides

across.

Fill with fiber.

Leaving yarn for an leg to sew.







### TAIL:

Let's start with White:

R 1: 6sc in MR

**R 2:** (2sc, inc)\*2. [8]

Change to Brown yarn:

**R 3:** (3sc, inc)\*2. [10]

**R 4 - 5:** 10sc. (2 rows)

R 6: 1sc. and fold the top

opening flat and 5sc, through

both sides across.

Leaving yarn for an tail to sew.



## NOSE:

With Black yarn:

R 1: 3sc in MR, ch, turn.

R 2: 3inc, ch, turn. [6]

**R 3:** inc, 4sc, inc, ch, turn [8]


**R 4:** 8sc, ch, turn [8]

**R 5:** BLO 8sc, ch, turn [8]

R 6: 8sc, not cut yarn, leaving

yarn for the muzzle to sew.







### HEAD:

Let's start with White:

Make 7ch, from the 2nd ch from

hook:

R 1: 5sc, 3sc into the one stitch, 4sc,

1inc. [14]

**R 2:** inc, 4sc, 3inc, 4sc, 2inc. [20]

**R 3:** (4sc, inc)\*4. [24]

**R 4:** (3sc, inc)\*6. [30]

**R 5:** 30sc. (1 rows)





## Attentively crochet 6 and 7 rows.

R 6: 4sc, inc, Change to Brown yarn; (4sc, inc,)\*2, 3sc, 8inc of HDC, 3sc, inc. [42]

**R 7:** 21sc, (1**HDC**, inc, of **HDC**)\*8, 5sc. [50]

R 8 - 11: 50sc. (4 rows)

**R 12:** (23sc, dec)\*2. [48]

**R 13:** (6sc, dec)\*6. [42]

**R 14:** (5sc, dec)\*6. [36]

**R 15:** (4sc, dec)\*6. [30]

**R 16:** (3sc, dec)\*6. [24]

**R 17:** (2sc, dec)\*6. [18]

**R 18:** (1sc, dec)\*6. [12]

R 19: 6 dec.

Fill with fiber.

Let's start with Brown yarn:

R 1: 6sc in MR.

**R 2:** (inc)\*6. [12]

**R 3:** (inc)\*12. [24]

**R 4:** (3sc, 1inc)\*6. [30]

**R 5:** (4sc, 1inc)\*6. [36]

**R 6:** (5sc, 1inc)\*6. [42]

**R 7:** (6sc, 1inc)\*6. [48]

**R 8:** (7sc, 1inc)\*6. [54]

R 9: 9sc, 6sc leg, 24sc, 6sc leg, 3sc with

a tail. [54]

R 10: 2sc with tail, 12sc, (2sc, dec)\*6,

15sc. [48]

**R 11:** 48sc. (1 row)

**R 12:** 15sc, (1sc, 1dec)\*6, 15sc. [42]

**R 13 - 14:** 42sc. (2 rows)

R 15: (3sc, 1dec)\*3, 12sc, (3sc, dec)\*3

[36]

**R 16:** 12sc, 6dec, 12sc. [30]

**R 17:** 30sc. (1 row)

**R 18:** (3sc, 1dec)\*6, [24]

**R 19:** 24sc. (1 row)

R 20: 5sc, 5sc arm, 8sc, 5sc arm, 1sc.

[24]

**R 21:** (2sc, 1dec)\*6, [18]

R 22: 18 dec.

Finish off.

Fill with fiber.

Leaving yarn for an head to sew.











## ASSEMBLY:

- ✓ We do eye tightening. Introduce the yarn from the bottom of the head.
- ✓ We sew our noses and shape our mouths. Do muzzle stretching.
- ✓ Embroidered eyebrows. Embroider eyes white thread.



- ✓ We sew the head to the body, if necessary, add filler to the neck..
- ✓ Ears are attached to the head symmetrically.
